WHAT IS EDUCATION UNTIL 18 (AUSBILDUNG BIS 18)?

Education until 18 is an initiative of the Austrian Federal Government. It is aimed at ensuring that all young people in Austria complete a form of education beyond compulsory schooling by their 18th birthday. Education until 18 is based on the Austrian Compulsory Education and Training Act (ApflG).

WHY EDUCATION UNTIL 18?

- All young people should have a complete education to enable them to organise the rest of their lives independently and play an active role in society.
- Young people that complete education or training find a job more easily, improve their chances of earning more and live healthier and longer lives.

WHICH EDUCATION UNTIL 18?

There are a range of different education options for young people:

- School attendance of an academic secondary school (AHS), a vocational secondary or high school (e. g.: HAS, HAK, HTL) or a school for agriculture and forestry
- Apprenticeship in one or more of the over 200 apprentice careers on offer, as an apprentice in a business or in a workshop (school and training-based apprenticeship with the Labour Market Service – AMS)
- Training in healthcare and social professions
- Other training and education offers, such as preparation courses training

Information and support is available for everyone at the coordinating offices for Education until 18:

- General information on Education until 18.

- Advice for young people not attending school or undergoing training, or who want to drop out of school or training.

WHAT I STILL NEED TO KNOW?

- Guardians, parents, and also schools and institutions, have a duty to report (on a young person's educational status).
- Before turning 18, going to work without undergoing a form of education is only allowed in exceptional cases.

Advice for young people is available with the Youth Coaching service from the Social Service Office (SMS):

- How can you best incorporate your talents into your professional life?
- Find out which job is most well suited to you.
- Get support for any challenges you are facing.

Information, referrals and consultations from the Austrian Public Employment Service (AMS):
